- 3. Youth that is homeless or is at risk of becoming homeless at age 16 or older.

Open Enrollment for these Foster Youth to Independence Vouchers (FYI) will remain open until all slots are filled. All preliminary applications will be received by: FSS of N. Florida and Changing Homelessness at: fyivouchers@fssnf.org

<u>Criteria:</u> The **ONLY** population eligible to be assisted with funding are youth certified by the named PCWA. Eligibility is not determined by the Jacksonville Housing Authority (JHA); therefore, JHA will not provide the application or eligibility.
